








GATE STREET GALLERY



Candia McKormack


Candia is the editor of Cotswold Life Magazine.










22 Bell Walk / Russell Haines




Russell Haines

He is an Honorary Fellow of The University of Gloucestershire, also Dad, tech geek & describes himself as an annoying optimist.




Rider Shafique










29 Westgate Street / Janina Ramirez




Janina Ramirez
